# About University

Maa Pateswari University was established in 2023 and officially notified by the Government of Uttar Pradesh on 8 December 2023. Since its inception, the University has received recognition from the University Grants Commission and has been granted recognition under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act.

The University currently has approximately 182 affiliated colleges functioning as centers of higher education across the region. These colleges collectively offer around 50 academic programs in diverse streams and disciplines.

At present, nearly 70 students are enrolled in various postgraduate (PG) programs, while approximately 150 research scholars are pursuing Ph.D. programs in different subjects under the University.

## प्रतीक चिन्ह (एम्बलम)



माँ पाटेश्वरी विश्वविद्यालय के एम्बलम में कई प्रतीकात्मक तत्व हैं, एम्बलम में निहित प्रतीकों का विवरण इस प्रकार है:

**1. माँ पाटेश्वरी (देवी की आकृति):** एम्बलम के केंद्र में स्थित आकृति माँ पाटेश्वरी का प्रतिनिधित्व करती है, जो इस क्षेत्र में पूजनीय देवी हैं और आदि शक्ति का प्रतीक हैं, जो ब्रह्मांड की सृष्टि, पालन-पोषण और संहार के पीछे की दिव्य शक्ति हैं। यह विश्वविद्यालय और स्थानीय जनता के बीच पारंपरिक और आध्यात्मिक रूप से घनिष्ठ संबंध को दर्शाता है। देवी ज्ञान, बुद्धि और दिव्य मार्गदर्शन प्रदान करके अज्ञान से उत्पन्न सभी दुःखों को दूर करने वाली देवी का भी प्रतीक हैं।

**2. सूर्य की किरणें:** देवी के सिर से निकलने वाली प्रकाश की किरणें ज्ञान, प्रबुद्धता और अंधकार (अज्ञान) के निवारण का प्रतीक हैं। यह विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा अपने छात्रों को प्रबुद्ध करने और उन्हें दुनिया की चुनौतियों का सामना करने के लिए तैयार करने में निभाई गई भूमिका को दर्शाता है।

**3. दीपक (दीया):** देवी द्वारा धारण किया गया दीपक ज्ञान और प्रबुद्धता का एक विशिष्ट प्रतीक है। दीपक का प्रकाश अंधकार और अज्ञान को दूर करने की शिक्षा की शक्ति का प्रतिनिधित्व करता है।

**4. कमल का फूल:** कमल पवित्रता, आध्यात्मिकता और जागृति का प्रतीक है। यह विश्वविद्यालय के विचारों की पवित्रता और सत्यनिष्ठा एवं ज्ञान जैसे मूल्यों से गहरे जुड़ाव को बढ़ावा देने के लक्ष्य का प्रतिनिधित्व करता है।

**5. संस्कृत आदर्श वाक्य:** नीचे संस्कृत में लिखा हुआ वाक्यांश **"भद्रं भद्रं क्रतुमस्मासु धेहि"** ऋग्वेद का एक अंश है, जो विशेष रूप से प्रथम मंडल, 89वें श्लोक (ऋग्वेद 1.89.1) में पाया जाता है। यह मंत्र शुभता और कल्याण के लिए प्रार्थना है, जो अच्छे विचारों, कार्यों और विभिन्न प्रयासों में सफलता के लिए आशीर्वाद का आह्वान करता है। इसका अनुवाद इस प्रकार किया जा सकता है: "हमें शुभता, शुभ विचार और कर्म प्राप्त हों। हम दिव्य मार्गदर्शन और ज्ञान प्रदान करें।" यह मंत्र दिव्य मार्गदर्शन, शुभता और सभी प्रयासों में सफलता पर वैदिक जोर को दर्शाता है, जो हमारे विश्वविद्यालय के मूल्यों के अनुरूप है।

**6. वृत्ताकार सूर्य चिह्न:** वृत्ताकार सूर्य चिह्न जीवन, ऊर्जा और प्रेरणा पर और अधिक बल देता है। यह अनंत विकास और संभावनाओं का प्रतीक है, जैसे सूर्य सभी को जीवन और आशा प्रदान करता है।

एम्बलम के ये सभी तत्व मिलकर विश्वविद्यालय के उस दृष्टिकोण को दर्शाते हैं जिसके तहत वह अपने छात्रों को शैक्षणिक, बौद्धिक और आध्यात्मिक विकास प्रदान करता है, और उन्हें ज्ञान, सफलता और बुद्धिमत्ता की ओर मार्गदर्शन करता है।

# University Emblem



The Emblem of Maa Pateswari University features several symbolic elements, each contributing to the university's identity and values. Here's a brief description of the symbolism in the Emblem:

- 1. Maa Pateswari (Deity Figure):** The central figure in the logo represents **Maa Pateswari**, a revered goddess in the region, symbolizing Aadi Shakti, the divine power, behind creation, sustenance and dissolution of the universe. It highlights the close connection of university with the local populace traditionally and spiritually. The goddess also symbolizes as remover of all ignorance born grief by imparting **knowledge, wisdom, and divine guidance**.
- 2. Sun Rays:** The rays of light emanating from the head of the goddess symbolize **illumination, knowledge, and the dispelling of darkness** (ignorance). This reflects the role of the university in enlightening its students and preparing them to face the challenges of the world.
- 3. Lamp (Diya):** The lamp held by the goddess is a classic symbol of **knowledge and enlightenment**. The light from the lamp represents the power of education to dispel darkness and ignorance.
- 4. Lotus Flower:** The lotus symbolizes **purity, spirituality, and awakening**. It represents the university's goal of fostering purity of thought and a deep connection to values such as integrity and enlightenment.
- 5. Sanskrit Motto:** The phrase at the bottom, written in Sanskrit, reads "**Bhadram Bhadram Kratum-asmasu dhehi** ," is part of the **Rigveda**, specifically found in the **1st Mandala, 89th Hymn (Rigveda 1.89.1)**. This mantra is a prayer for auspiciousness and welfare, invoking blessings for good thoughts, actions, and success in various endeavors. The phrase can be translated as: "**May auspiciousness, auspicious thoughts, and actions be ours. Grant us divine guidance and wisdom.**" The mantra reflects the Vedic emphasis on **divine guidance, auspiciousness, and success** in all endeavors, which aligns with the values of our University.
- 6. Circular Sun Icon:** The circular sun symbol further emphasizes **life, energy, and inspiration**. It suggests the idea of endless growth and potential, as the sun gives life and hope to all.

Together, these elements in the logo reflect the university's vision of providing academic, intellectual, and spiritual growth to its students, guiding them towards knowledge, success, and wisdom.

# स्नातक और परास्नातक कार्यक्रमों में प्रवेश

माँ पाटेश्वरी विश्वविद्यालय, बलरामपुर, शैक्षणिक सत्र 2026-27 के लिए परिसर में विभिन्न स्नातक और परास्नातककार्यक्रमों में प्रवेश के लिए पात्र उम्मीदवारों से ऑनलाइन आवेदन आमंत्रित करता है। प्रवेश, कार्यक्रमों, सीटों और पात्रता से संबंधित विवरण नीचे दिए गए हैं और आधिकारिक वेबसाइट पर भी उपलब्ध हैं। प्रवेश विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा जारी की जाने वाली मेरिट सूची के आधार पर होगा।

सभी स्नातक और परास्नातककार्यक्रमों में कार्यक्रम चयन शुल्क सामान्य और ओबीसी (गैर-क्रीमी परत) उम्मीदवारों के लिए 1000 रुपये और अनुसूचित जाति और अनुसूचित जनजाति उम्मीदवारों के लिए 700 रुपये है।

## Admission In UG and PG Programs

Maa Pateswari University, Balrampur hereby invites online application for admission to various Under Graduate and Post Graduate programs in the Campus from eligible candidates for the academic session 2026-27. Details related to admission, programs, seats and eligibilities are given below and also available on the official website.

The admission will be based on merit list which will be released by the university. The fee for program selection for programs offered by campus in all UG programs is Rs 500/- and for PG programs is Rs 1000/-.

Admissions are now open for the first year/first semester of the following UG and PG programs for the academic session 2026-27. The number of seats for UG and PG program is given in the table. In compliance with the government order regarding EWS (Economically Weaker Sections), admissions under the EWS category will be carried out as per the following details:
